

# A Good Plan in Succeeding a Way out

- An 83 year old lady presented with NYHA III symptoms. She had a background of mitral valve repair with Seguin Annuloplasty Ring size 28 for severe mitral regurgitation due to ruptured chordae at P2/P3 segment.
- Echocardiogram showed LVEF of 56%, severe eccentric MR. Her STS mortality for MVR was 12%. Heart Team concluded that patient was deemed surgically inoperable and suggested for TMVR.
- CT analysis showed small NeoLVOT area and proceeded for pre-emptive alcohol septal ablation.
- After 4 weeks, repeated CT showed adequate NeoLVOT area and hence proceeded for TMVR
- Since the ring is invisible, LA angiogram and TEE are useful tools to guide for TMVR deployment.
